Open to Junior, Amateur, and Professionals in all classes, ties involving first place will be jumped off. In ties not involving first place, times taken in the first round will separate those tied with equal faults. All jumper classes are judged under Section II, Table 2b.

Hunter Division

Open to Junior and Amateur riders at entry level.

Exhibitors in this division may NOT cross enter into any classes set at 2'3" or higher at this show.

Cross Rail Hunters

Classes 15, 16, 17, 18, 19

Cross Rail classes are for entry level riders and have been developed to create an educational ladder for the beginning rider. Exhibitors in the Cross Rail classes may NOT cross enter into any classes set at 2'3" or higher at this show. Fences are no higher than 12". Courses will be very simple. Riders will not be penalized for trotting.

Green Rider Division

Rules and General Information

Minor Exhibitors: Parents or guardians of minor exhibitors shall hold PDM Stables harmless for injury to such minor. No minor's entry blank will be accepted unless signed by a parent or guardian.

Management: The horse show management reserves the right to itself to interpret all questions and conditions in regard to or rising out of incident to the show without claims from damages or recourse of any kind. All questions not covered in these rules and regulations shall be decided by the Horse Show Management and their decisions will be final.

Entry Procedures: Only ONE horse per entry sheet. Send your completely filled out entry blank on or before the closing date of entries. An open check, cash or major credit card are required before the office will issue a number. **Late entries are subject to a \$20 late entry fee.**

Stabling: Stalls are available for \$15 per night. Stalls are pre-bedded. Feed is not provided.

Abuse: Competitors who abuse horses will be eliminated by the judge and may be subject to removal from the show grounds. Excessive abuse includes, but is not limited to, use of whip four or more times and/or use of the whip in front of the horse's shoulder.

Helmets: All riders in Hunter, Jumper and Hunt Seat Equitation classes where jumping is required and all riders when jumping anywhere on the competition grounds, must wear properly fitting protective headgear that meets or exceeds ASTM/SEI standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag. The harness must be secured. Additionally, the above headgear requirements are mandatory for juniors and strongly encouraged for adults while riding on the flat anywhere on the competition grounds.
